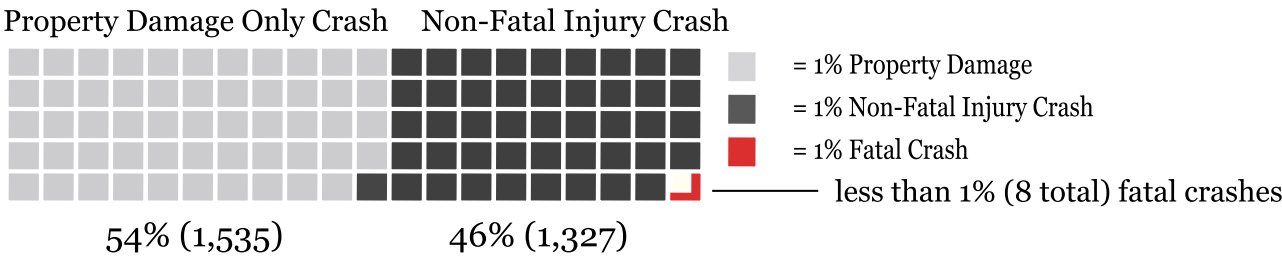

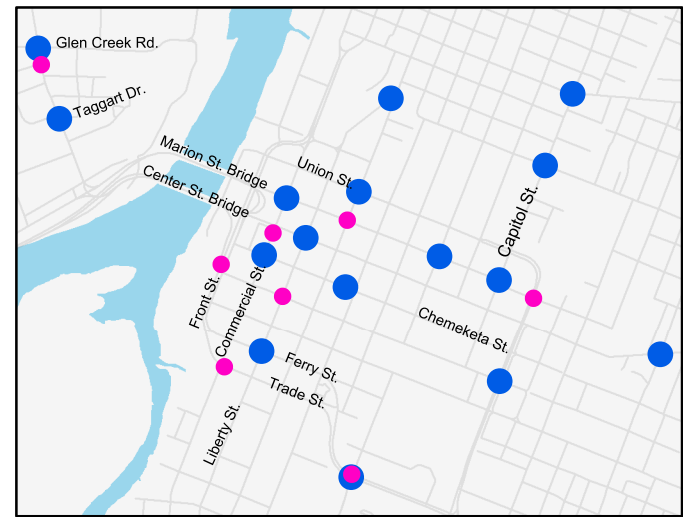

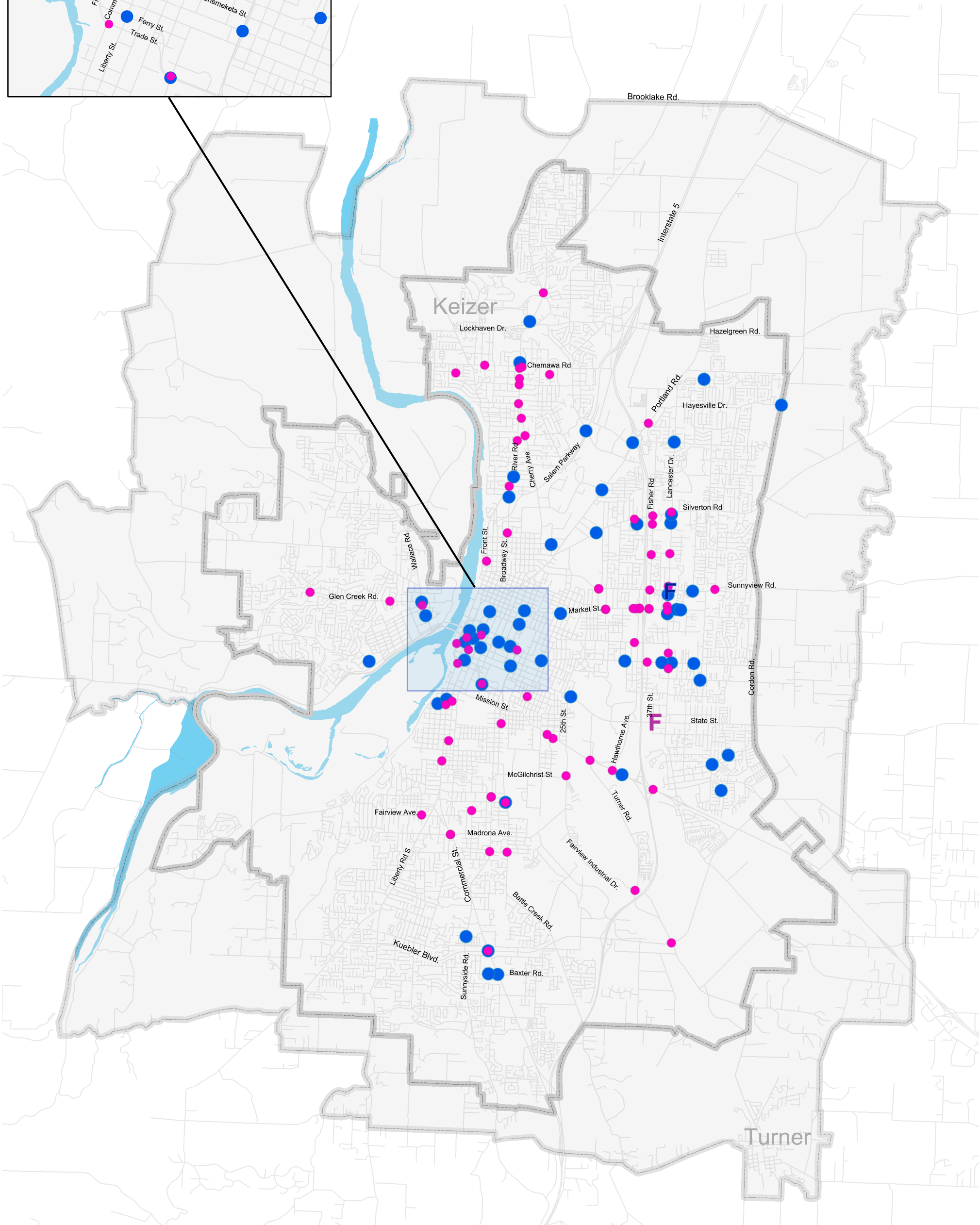

Most crashes

Crash data is provided by the Oregon Department of Transportation Crash Analysis and Reporting Unit on a semi-annual basis.  
A crash must be reported by the driver if the crash results in (as of 2004): Death, Bodily injury, Damage to the driver's vehicle is over \$1,500,  
Damage to any vehicle is over \$1,500 and any vehicle is towed from the scene as a result of damage from the accident;  
Damage to any one person's property other than a vehicle involved in the accident is over \$1,500.

\*As of 01/01/2004, only drivers are required to file a report. Drivers must file an Accident and Insurance Report Form with DMV within 72 hours if they are involved in a crash resulting in any of the following:

- Death
- Bodily injury
- Damage to the vehicle you were driving is over \$1,500
- Damage to any vehicle is over \$1,500 and any vehicle is towed from the scene as a result of damage from the accident.
- Damage to any one person's property other than a vehicle involved in the accident is over \$1,500.
